

What is the Mobile Food Pantry Program?

The **MOBILE FOOD PANTRY PROGRAM** provides nutritious grocery staples to individuals in the remote areas of Brown County who are often underserved due to lack of transportation, health issues or economic hardships.

Good Samaritan Ministries works in partnership with area churches to identify those who would qualify for the program and to train volunteers who will be responsible for packing and distributing the boxes as well as all necessary record keeping.

Why is it Called "Mobile"?

Good Samaritan will take its normal pantry operations from the offices at 305 Clark Street to the partner churches where clients will be interviewed, and those who qualify will receive a box of food. Interview paperwork will be returned to the GSM office where it will be kept for security and confidentiality.

What's Included in a Box?

The Mobile Food Pantry will utilize the same USDA products that are available to clients who come to the Good Samaritan facility. Examples include:

canned beans
cereal or rice
fruit juice
canned fruit
peanut butter
canned tuna/salmon
raisins
beef stew or pork meal

Miscellaneous products such as bread and snack foods may be added when available.

Mobile Pantry Eligibility Guidelines

- A client must show proof of Brown County residence. A piece of mail such as a utility bill that is no older than **30 days** is an example of an acceptable document.
- At the time of registration and once a year, clients must show Social Security cards for all household members listed on a file.
- The partner churches will schedule a monthly distribution date that will be advertised and posted in advance.
- There can be only one file per address.
- Clients can only receive food once a month from either the GSM facility in Brownwood or the Mobile Food Pantry but not both.

How Can YOU Be a Part?

- ◆ You can pack food boxes for monthly distribution.
- You can volunteer at Good Samaritan Ministries to learn more about all of our hunger ministries
- You can support the Mobile Food Pantry Program financially. It costs approximately \$40 to provide one box of food for a family.
- You can pray for the program, the volunteers, the recipients and the GSM staff.

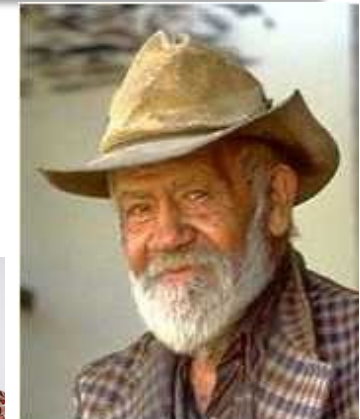
